Assignment Title: Baseline Social and Customers Satisfaction Survey

The Republic of Serbia / Republic Geodetic Authority has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Real Estate Management Project, and intends to the engage of Consultant firm to conduct **Baseline Social and Customers Satisfaction Survey**

The objective of the REMP is to improve the efficiency, transparency, accessibility and reliability of the Republic of Serbia's real property management systems.

In that respect the REMP envisages obtaining feedback from direct project beneficiaries through customer satisfaction and perception surveys and the establishment of regular customers satisfaction monitoring, and targeted meetings and analysis to discuss how this feedback can be used to improve project outcomes

Consultant firm will have to provide services required to meet the overall objective of this assignment, which is to enable RGA to become more responsive to citizens expectations through the establishment of elements of a public performance monitoring while at the same time establishing a baseline for evaluation of selected REMP intervention results.

More specifically objectives of this Assignment are:

- To advise policy makers and RGA operations management on citizens' and the business community's perceived needs and expectations.
- To establish baseline data for the measurement of the REMP results and determine indicators for the monitoring surveys in the third and fifth years of the REMP.
- To design and pilot the establishment of regular quarterly monitoring of customers satisfaction with RGA service provision.

In order to meet the assignment objectives the Consultant will have to conduct following activities:

- Focus groups with general public with RGA staff
- Individual interviews with business community
- Two stratified surveys. One with citizens with at least 1500 forms completed (including training and report writing) and second with business community with at least 400 forms completed (including training and report writing)

- Detailed methodology and implementation plan for continuous RGA customer satisfaction monitoring
- Testing of the proposed internal monitoring business solution (including web-based application, questionnaire and training)
- Final report compilation

The Project Implementation Unit (PIU) of the Republic Geodetic Authority now invites eligible consulting firms to indicate their interest in providing the above-mentioned services. Interested consulting firms must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services:

- experience and description of similar assignments
- availability of skilled staff
- CVs of key personnel that would be contracted for the assignment.

The shortlisting criteria are:

- The successful Consultant will have at least 3 years experience in social and/or market mixed-methods (qualitative and quantitative) research and must demonstrate that they have the professional understanding and resources to carry out the required work in a short period of time. The expression of interest must include reference to work previously done, CVs of key staff who the contractor guarantees will work on the project if the contract is awarded.
- The Consultant will provide details of three clients of the similar surveys conducted in last 5 years with contracted amount exceeding 25,000€ for each reference who are willing to provide references.

The following selection criteria with corresponding points will be used to create a short list of Consultants, which will be invited to submit their proposals:

 Qualifications for the assignment
 Competence for the assignment
