- 1. This invitation for bids follows the General Procurement Notice (GPN) for this project that appeared in UNDB online on **April 16, 2015**.
 - 2. The Republic of Serbia Republic Geodetic Authority (RGZ) has received a loan from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development toward the cost of the Real Estate Management Project, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to payments under the agreement(s) resulting from this IFB: Improvement and maintenance of the information system ISREC Phase I for 2021, IFB No.: SRB-REMP-8486YF-NCB-TS-20-177
- 3. The Project Implementation Unit (PIU) of Republic Geodetic Authority serves as the implementing agency for the project and now invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for Improvement and maintenance of the information system ISREC Phase I for 2021.

ISREC Phase I (Workflow, DMS, UMS, Coding System) has been successfully implemented in all LCOs (Local Cadastre Offices) as well as in the RGA headquarter using Therefore software. Currently, Therefore has over 2000 end-users. Therefore TM DMS is produced by Canon and because of that Bidder must have MAF by Canon. RGA is owner of the source code related to additional functionalities and web services and this source code will be given to the selected company.

Improvement and maintenance of the information system ISREC Phase I for 2021 should provide:

- Functional upgrades of the existing system (implementation of additional business processes for Financial Department, upgrade of existing integration between DMS and eFrontDesk System (eŠalter) new web service methods, redesign and optimization of new workflows according to upgraded Real Estate Cadaster procedures etc.;
- Document Management System Service Level Agreement (SLA).

This arrangement should last one year.

- 3. Bidding will be conducted through the national competitive bidding procedures specified in the World Bank's Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works, and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants, by World Bank Borrowers, issued in January 2011, revised in July 2014, and is open to all Bidders eligible as defined in these Guidelines, that meet the following minimum qualification criteria:
 - (i) During the past five (5) years (2016-2020), the Bidder must have completed at least one (1) successful contract with implementation of Document Management System and Workflow Management System with at least 300 end users and integrated in an existing IT infrastructure. To prove this, bidder must submit original statement, signed by the client, with requested information. Also, original statements signed by the client must have name of the client's contact person, title, address, phone and e-mail (Form 3.5.3a).
 - (ii) The offered DMS and Workflow management solution must have at least one (1) successful implementation in Real Estate Cadaster Institution. To prove this, bidder must submit original statement, signed by the client, with requested information. Also, original statements signed by the client must have name of the client's contact person, title, address, phone and e-mail (Form 3.5.3a).
 - (iii) At least one person with more than 10 years of experience in Project Management and with PMP, Prince or similar certificate. To prove this, bidder must submit CV signed by expert and valid certificate.
 - (iv) At least one (1) persons with more than 5 (five) years of experience in software development using same technology stack as offered solution. To prove this, bidder must submit CV signed by expert.
 - (v) The successful bidder must have the following support capabilities, during warranty period, or must demonstrate in the bid documentation a credible plan for establishing such capabilities by the contract signing:
 - Help-Desk telephone service with automatic problems application must be active 24 hours, every day.
 - For problems that cannot be resolved by telephone that are notified within 8:00am-8:00pm Monday through Sunday, qualified service personnel must be able to arrive on-site and start problem resolving by best effort manner within 6 hours of problem escalation.
 - (vi) The bidder must be authorized for implementation, improvement and maintenance of Document Management System ThereforeTM. The authorization letter must be provided by local Canon representative office."
- 5. Interested eligible Bidders may obtain further information from the **Project Implementation Unit** of Republic Geodetic Authority and inspect the bidding documents at the address given below from 09:00 to 15:00 hours.

6. A complete set of bidding documents, available in English only, may be purchased by interested bidders on the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee **EUR 100.00** or equivalent in Serbian Dinars based on the selling exchange rate published by the National Bank of Serbia on the date of payment.

Bids will be opened in the presence of the Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address below at 12:15 local time on **January 27, 2021**, in the PIU premises at the mezzanine.
- 8. The attention of prospective Bidders is drawn to (i) the fact that they will be required to certify in their bids that all software is either covered by a valid license or was produced by the Bidder and (ii) that violations are considered fraud, which can result in ineligibility to be awarded World Bank-financed contracts.

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
